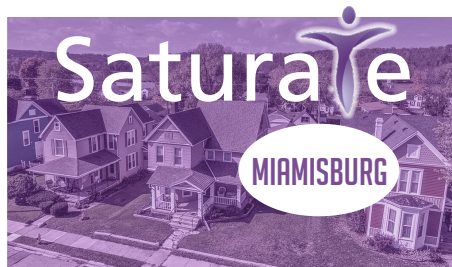




# COMMUNITY OUTREACH 2021 STRATEGIC PLAN
